## Cybersecurity

The job of a cybersecurity team is to try to find vulnerabilities in software or websites that allow someone to get information or access that they shouldn't have. To find those vulnerabilities. the cybersecurity team--often called pen testers or white hat hackers-has to try to break into the website or product. Sometimes this can mean finding issues in the software or code that allow unintended access, but it can also mean exploiting human errors like easy to guess passwords or even trying to trick people into giving out sensitive information (which is called social engineering). The best cybersecurity experts then help fix these issues to prevent them from happening again!
