Machine Learning

Machine learning is a way to teach a computer a complicated concept by giving the computer a lot of examples of the thing you want it to learn. Computers can use the examples to teach themselves by picking out patterns and similarities in the examples and then applying those patterns to new data. This method makes it much easier to teach computers complicated tasks, but the computer is only as good as the examples it's given. A bad set of examples can have unintended consequences.

Lesson idea:

- 1. Introduce Laura Gómez and machine learning with the information above
- 2. Watch <u>this video</u> (4:49) where Laura Gómez answers 20 questions about her life, career, and thoughts on Al
- 3. Explore machine learning: Have students read this article to learn more about how Al can do a bad job in selecting candidates for a job,. Then have them try to create their own hiring Al using Machine Learning for Kids. Have students choose what to look for in a candidate's resume and build an Al that will look for those words. (Younger students can instead build an image-based model to guess what job someone does by looking at the way they're dressed.)
